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Suggested Sequence for Architecture Classes

Students should use the following guide as a suggested sequence for taking classes for completion of the Architecture Certificate.

First Semester	BUSAD 152, T Ed 140*, T Ed 142*, Art 130, and/or Arch 101.
Second Semester	Arch 102*, 103, 105, 106 (on-line), Arch 108 (on-line), Arch 141, 250 and/or Engr 109.
Third Semester	Arch 120, 130, 229 (if Engr 109 was taken), 251 and/or 252 plus any class from the second semester.
Forth Semester	Arch 125* (If Arch 120 was completed) Arch 135* (If Arch 130 was completed) Arch 230 (If Arch 229 was completed) plus any classes from the second and third semesters.
