Glendale Community College works with Glendale, Burbank, and Los Angeles Unified School District to bring our Dual Enrollment opportunities to your high school! Dual Enrollment, serving over 600 students each year, has allowed them to jump-start their college pathway while still enrolled in high school. Students can take advantage of this **FREE** opportunity at one of over eight campuses throughout the districts. By taking advantage of these offerings, **many of our Dual Enrollment students have graduated high school with over 15 college credits completed, springing them through the college pathway.** This opportunity has saved students much time and money on their higher education journey. This fall semester, we will proudly welcome the first cohort of students to the Early College Academy at Herbert Hoover High School, part of Glendale Unified. Through this collaborative partnership, we have designed a program that will allow students to take college courses during their regular school schedule. **Students in the Early College Academy begin the college pathway in the 10th grade and will be able to complete 45 college credits by the time they earn their high school diploma.** The Early College Academy application is open for all students who are enrolled in the 9th grade each January.
