How Estudiantes Unidos Works

This program is designed as a dialogue between GCC leaders, administrators, managers and the students in the program.

Each week, participants will have an opportunity to learn about different areas of the campus and begin to look at the gaps in services they feel students need.

Once participants have identified these needs, the group works to advocate and implement a project to achieve the desired goals and outcome.

The purpose is to have students who are empowered to come up with solutions to help their fellow students.

The program has 3 parts:

Part 1 – Meet/Dialogue with GCC Leaders

Part 2 – Brainstorm and choose a project

Part 3 – Complete the project in the spring semester

PROJECT EXAMPLE

Last year, students created a mentoring program for undocumented high school students.

Applications are Due Tuesday, September 10 at 12:00 Noon!

Program Commitment

All participants must commit to the following:

6-hour Training (Sept. 14, 2019)

9 one-hour weekly sessions (fall 2019-see below)

15-20 hours for completing project (spring 2019)

There is a stipend of up to \$250 in the fall (paid in December)

And a stipend of up to \$350 in the spring (paid in May).

Stipend amount is dependent on level of participation.
