STAR TRAINING

**The required 6 hour training is set for Saturday, March 14,
from 10:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on campus!**

This is the only training session for the semester.

Once you turn in this application, you will receive a confirmation and information about the training location. We will also call to confirm your attendance as we get closer to the training date.



During the training, you will be actively doing the lessons that you will be facilitating with the students in the classroom. ***Please dress comfortably as you will be moving around. This training is not lecture format.***

STAR WEEKLY COMMITMENT

You must have a minimum two-hour block of time available during the week. The block of time can be anytime between 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. The more hours you are available, the easier it is to find you a placement. You must commit to delivering the STAR program **one hour per week for 7 to 8 weeks** in the same classroom.

TB TEST – REQUIRED BY THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Since you will be going to a public school,
you must get a TB test done AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
It takes 72 hours (3 days) to get the results of your test.

TB tests are free at the GCC Health Center.

They are offered on Monday, Tuesdays, and Fridays.

No Appointment is necessary.

Please do this test as soon as possible. Bring a copy of result to the MCEC.

You will be generally partnered with one or two other students in the program. The number of partners and your school site will depend on a number of *factors such as, your available time, teacher requests for facilitators, diversity of the team, number of students in the program, etc.*

The middle and high schools that participate in the program vary each semester. Schools that have participated in the past include: *Glendale, Hoover, Marshall, Franklin, Verdugo Hills, Burbank, and Eagle Rock High Schools.* The middle schools include *Roosevelt, Rosemont, Washington Irving, and Eagle Rock.* Again, this list varies each semester.

There is no guarantee of partners or school sites. We must consider all the requests received and the availability of students in matching partners and schools. We will make every attempt to match you with preferred partners, but no guarantees.

You do not need to be enrolled in a SPECIFIC course to participate in the program. The program is open to all current GCC students.
