This program is designed as a dialogue between GCC leaders, administrators, managers, and the students in the program.

Each week, participants will have an opportunity to learn about different areas of the campus and meet leaders in those areas.

Following meetings, students begin to look at the gaps in services that they believe exists on campus.

Once participants have identified these needs, the group works to advocate and implement a project to achieve the desired goals and outcomes. The purpose is to have students who are empowered to come up with solutions to help their fellow students.

So basically, The program has three parts:

Part 1 – Meet/Dialogue with GCC Leaders

Part 2 – Brainstorm and choose a project

Part 3 – Complete the project in the spring semester

Examples of Past Projects

Last year, students planned and organized a one-day event for new Latinx students and their families.

Another project involved holding informational meetings and reaching out to Latinx students to provide information about transfer, financial aid, and scholarships.

Estudiantes Unidos Program Commitment

All participants must commit to the following:
4-hour Training (January 8, 2021)
4 one-hour weekly sessions (see below)
15-20 hours for completing project (spring 2021)

There is a stipend of up to \$250 in the winter and a stipend of up to \$350 in the spring. Stipend amount is dependent on level of participation and will be paid in May (in one payment).
