



Guide with Pride Mentor Information Sheet

The Guide with Pride @ GCC is a mentoring program designed for any student who identifies as LGBTQ+ at GCC to help with staying engaged and connected and to be academically successful.

Mentor Requirements

- Identify as LGBTQ+ (*you won't be outed!*)
- Attend a 3 hour mentor orientation/ training (*Training will be held on Friday, September 17th, 12:00 Noon to 3:00 p.m.*)
- Attend the 1 hour mentee orientation (*Orientation will be held on Thursday, September 23rd, 12:00 Noon to 1:00 p.m.*)
- Attend a GCC Safe Zone Training (during the academic year)
- Be validating and open to learning about ALL LGBTQ+ identities
- Be currently enrolled as a GCC credit or non-credit student in 6 or more units
- Communicate with your mentee once a week (minimum)
- Attend mentor/mentee activities
- Mentor pay rate is \$15 per hour

All Activities and meetings will be remote (for the time being)

Mentor Responsibilities

- Meet with mentees throughout the semester to provide motivation, support, and resources
- Provide guidance with navigating the GCC campus and advancing their educational goals
- Offer support in finding community resources within the greater Los Angeles area
- Provide support for students who are in the process of coming out, or feel they are currently unable to come out
- Help students explore issues related to professional development
- Develop connections with networks, people, and groups on campus
- Address the mentee's individual needs

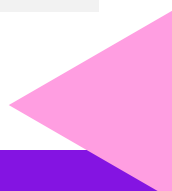
