1. Scholars Advisory Committee

- Fundraising Committee had their first fundraiser.
- Arts and Culture is working on the scholars journals.
- Dodger Arena is considering adding a transcript notation for all the scholars members.
- The committee has gone over the winter and spring semesters' attendance and credits.
- Scholars entrance for spring 2022 is held and the orientation will proceed.

2. Academic Calendar Committee

3. Library and Information Competency

- The library is now open in person but not all parts of it because there is a low staffing issue.
- Technology is being improved and the library will provide it, while the IT team will provide all the hardware support.
- Library said that students can reserve rooms for studying and etc, and in order to use the on campus resources students need to have a wristband.
- The committee is hiring for an outreach librarian, and the job is to reach out to faculty and staff and let them know how to get in touch with the students and the library.

XIV. Guest Speakers

1. Drew Yamanishi – Dean of Student Services

- There have been reforms regarding placement in the math and ESL classes in GCC.
- For over 20 years students would be forced to take basic level classes, which will cause them to fall behind the program, waste a lot of time and even drop out before they get to the transfer point.
- The law states that students need to be placed in the transfer level classes.
- The speaker has showed some statistic regarding the completion of classes over years in English and Math classes.
- 14% of Hispanic students have completed transfer level math requirement in one year after the 8705 implementation.
