Free Parking Permits

GCC is offering free parking for the entire fall semester. However, you must display a parking permit in your vehicle to avoid being ticketed. Verdugo Road that honor the GCC student parking permit. You can pick up your free parking permit at the Tuition Office (SV314) on the 3rd floor of Sierra Vista.

GCC GoPass (Free to all students)

We are happy to announce this year that we are offering the GCC GoPass to all students. The GCC GoPass will allow you to travel on all L.A. Metro buses and trains, Glendale Beeline buses and nearly ten other municipal transits. Be sure to register to get your pass which you can use to get to school, to work, or just for fun.
