Foremost, I hope this message finds you and your families safe. We are beginning an important transition as we reopen our campuses tomorrow, January 15th 2025. While we are fortunate to resume normal operations for the College, we continue to be focused on those employees and students who have been impacted in varying degrees by the tremendous destruction caused by the fires and strong winds.

The College has completed the work required to safely re-open all campuses. Interior air quality in each building has been tested by an external air quality expert and has been determined to be safe. With these actions completed, **all campuses will reopen Wednesday, January 15th 2025 and in person instruction and services will resume.**

Things to Know For Re-Opening

While there is no longer need for masking for employees or students, KN95 masks will be available for anyone who wishes to use them. Please keep exterior doors, windows, and window screens closed to minimize debris from entering our buildings.

Please refrain from entering the "Old Gym" in the Vaquero Athletic Complex. The new gym, fitness center, student locker rooms, athletic training facilities and weight room are all open and accessible. The Old Gym will remain locked and marked with caution tape until the final repairs on the roof are complete.

If you have been directly impacted by this emergency, please prioritize your well-being and that of your family. If you are unable to return to work tomorrow, please notify your supervisor so support can be provided.
