

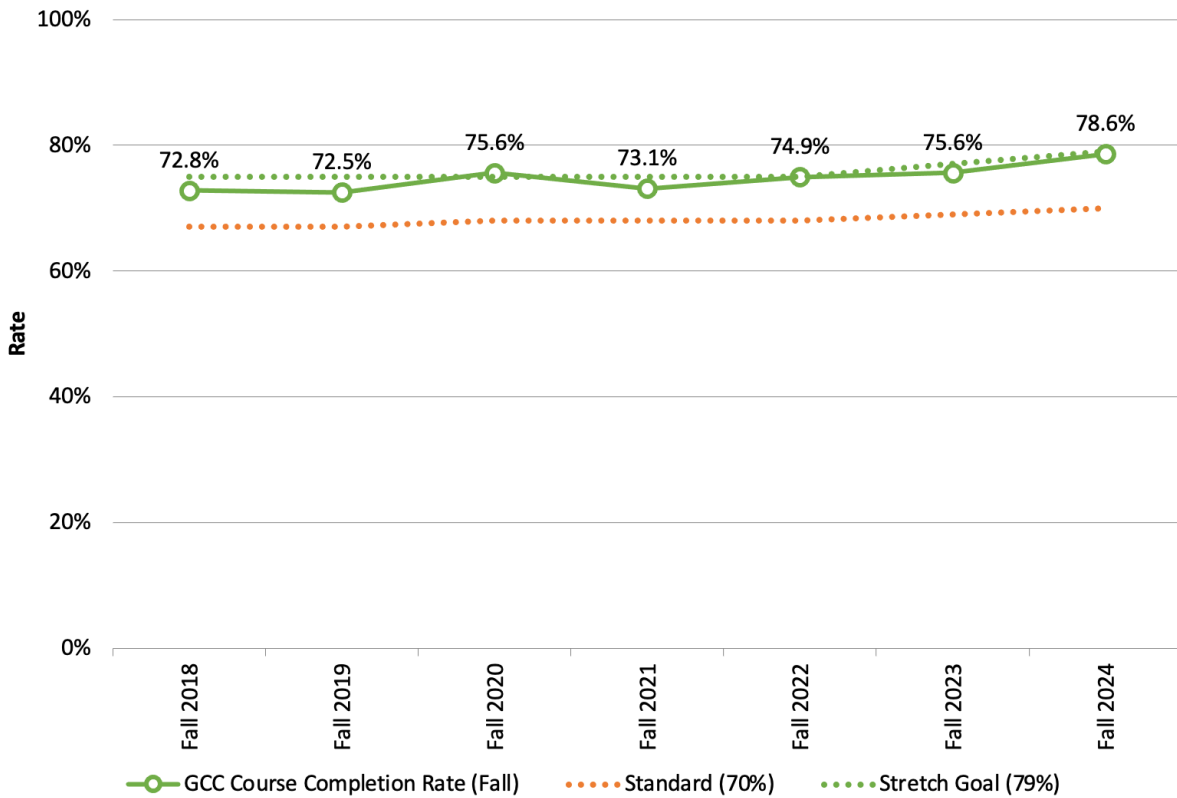


Report on Institution-Set Standards for Student Achievement 2024-2025

Glendale Community College has established the following standards for student achievement. This report shows how the college and its students are achieving these standards. The standards and updated trend data are reviewed annually by the Academic Senate and Strategic Planning Committee.

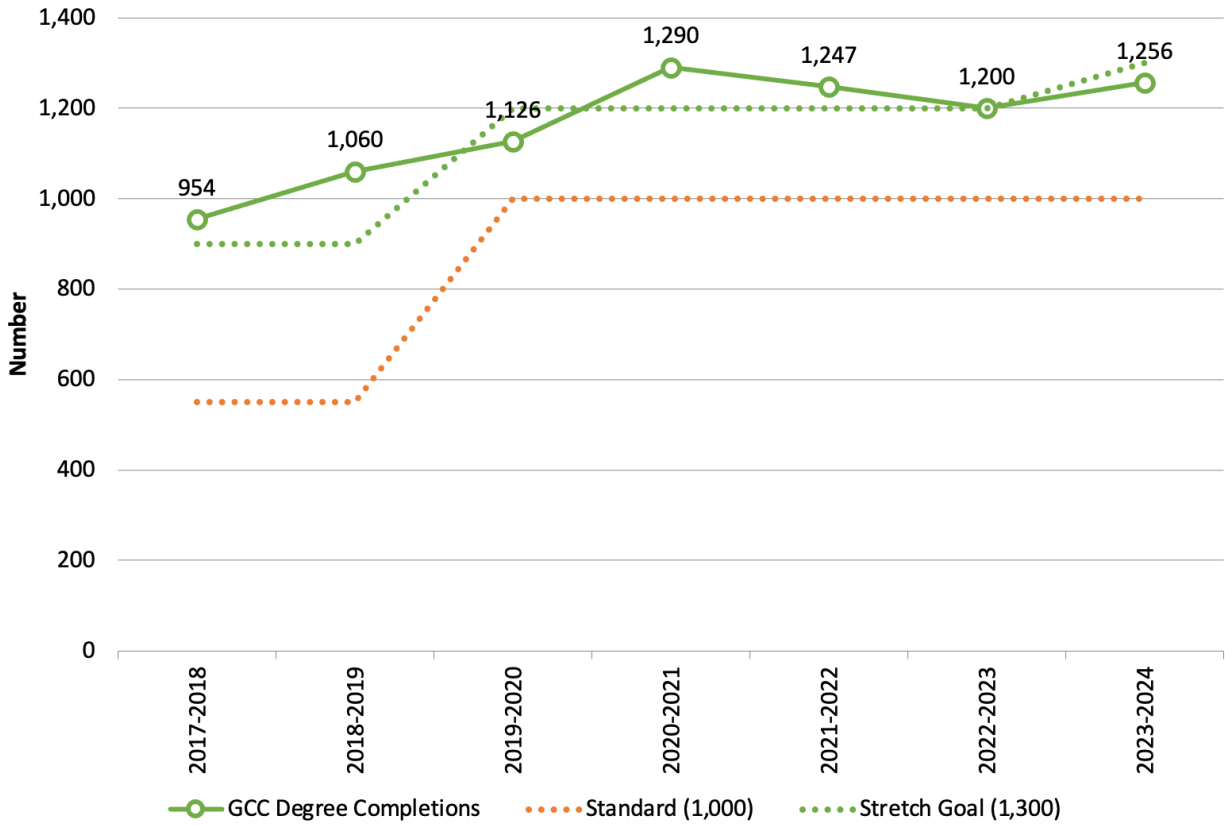
Standard 1. Course Completion Rate Institution-Set Standard: 70% Stretch Goal: 79%

Course completion rate is the percentage of credit Fall-semester enrollments at census resulting in a grade of A, B, C, or Pass.



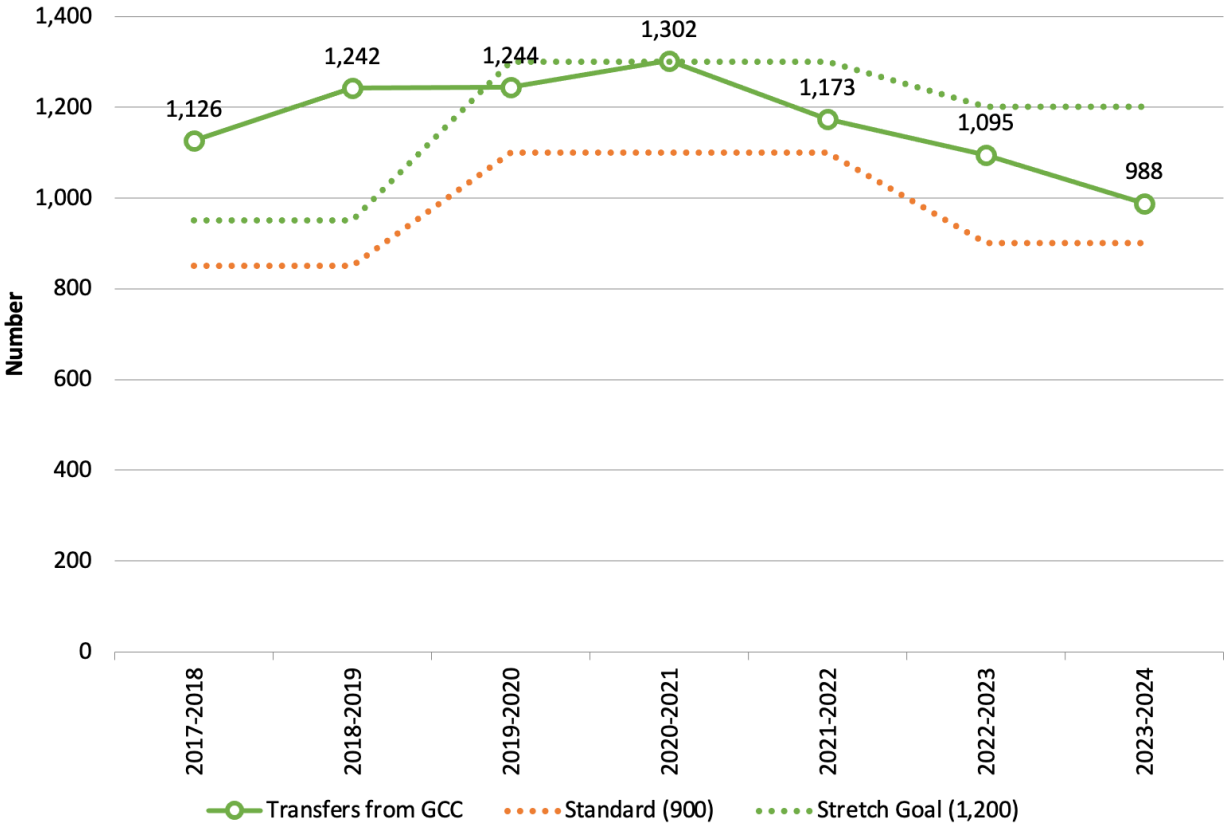
Standard 2. Degree Completion Institution-Set Standard: 1,000 Stretch Goal: 1,300

Degree completion is the total number of associate degrees awarded in an academic year, including Associate in Arts, Associate in Arts for Transfer, Associate in Science, and Associate in Science for Transfer.



Standard 3. Transfers
Institution-Set Standard: 900
Stretch Goal: 1,200

Transfers is the total number of students transferring to a UC or CSU institution in the academic year. Although data are available for transfers to independent and out-of-state institutions, the data are generally not available in a timely manner, so this standard was set based on transfers to UC and CSU institutions.



Standard 4. Certificate Completion
Institution-Set Standard: 350
Stretch Goal: 550

Certificate completion is the total number of credit certificates awarded in an academic year.
