XVI. New Business

- **Poster Printer - Discussion Item**
 - Claudia began by bringing up the choice between buying an entirely new printer or fixing the broken parts of the current one, given the current printer is 15 years old
 - Tzoler mentioned that printing on campus costs around \$30-35 per poster, and by having our own printer, we would save money
 - If we do end up buying the printer, Tzoler recommended buying the printer through a company and purchasing a warranty
- **ASGCC Student Representative Plan for Hiring Committees - Discussion Item**
 - Tzoler mentioned how we have challenges finding students to participate in hiring committees
 - Tzoler discussed with the VP of HR to make hiring committees more attractive to students through incentives
 - Tzoler mentioned having people on the ASGCC senator waitlist serve in hiring committees and create a process for that
