XIII. Reports of Governance/Special Committee Meetings

- **Library and Information Competency**
 - Alec began with how there was a discussion with the ethics of AI and how they are affecting class
 - All the professors haven't adjusted to AI yet
 - They want to make a system in which some AI is allowed for classwork while other assignments would not use AI at all
 - They would also want to use AI to make assignments and such
 - The school is debating whether they should charge for lost or damaged devices
 - They also want to change the times for requesting library rooms from an hour to 30 minutes
- **Release Time / Extra Pay (RTEP)**
 - Aline began with how the committee is playing catchup with all the employees that have to go through the system
 - Aline also clarified what the accommodations that actually take place are and how employees are accommodated when they take time off
 - There were also many concerns and suggestions from the faculty during the meeting and how there are minor changes that are to be made, which are difficult because these small decisions affect the bigger picture as well
 - Emily added that one of the governance members brought up fairness and the question between one employee doing more work than another
 - Aline also brought up how final decisions within the governance will typically involve the CEC committee and how if they are urgent they will go straight to CEC and not circle back to RTEP. The members of the committee were urging that this information does circle back for the sake of transparency
- **Campus Development**
 - David began with how they mentioned the measure GCC bond and how it was passed which brought us 600 million in bonds. The project is called IBCC and it will involve tearing down the Sierra Nevada complex and new buildings will be built in 2026 and it will last about 2 years
 - David then added how there was a proposition to talk about bulletin boards around campus for the students use, which was faced with heavy retaliation
 - David then moved on to the Camino Real project which will include the new student spaces and departments with virtual reality
 - Katya added details with how they will move forward with the construction
 - Katya also added what the buildings will be used for, in this case music and dance and will include a concert hall
