1. **Budget Review Committee - Nathan Andriassian/Sayat Teker**
 - Experiencing enrollment challenges in non-credit courses as they increase in popularity
 - State funding is holding a 3-year average and moving from stability funding to state funding
 - Implementing the EPM budget system (electronic), tracking spending for spending transparency
 - Student course opportunities and meeting student education needs are the top priority
 - Adjusted budget policy and cash reserve with an increase of 5% for the cash reserve
2. **Committee on Distance Education - Vahan Manukyan/Karen Verdia**
 - AI detection tools are compared and discussed, causing too much stress in students as authentic work is being flagged for AI
 - The CCCO is implementing more firewalls
 - Approved classes for the upcoming term include French, human, and business administration
 - Include word count for answers and questions on response forms
 - Including more hands-on teaching for students and teachers to create better learning outcomes
 - POKER (peer online course review) - online course review to ensure it's a valid course
 - Hands-on recertification for faculty and hours counting for credit for professors who have not already
 - Discussed opinions with the AS student representative during the meeting, talking about struggles with bilingual thought process
 - Translation feature in Canvas, which can be helpful for math, but for a language class, it can be difficult - Google Chrome feature already implemented
 - DEI policy tabled for next meeting
 - Professors hate AI-influenced Canvas, with some professors not wanting to include it in courses
