 - Two social science courses were tabled due to the absence of the division chairs.

 - There was an emphasis on how STEM students are cheating.
 - They want to teach students to think critically instead of resorting to AI.
 - Want to change the canvas system, but they need the chancellors of UCs and CSUs to agree as well.
 - Talked about publishing what they need to, especially about publishing canvas shells before classes start, which causes confusion. It was said to clarify the confusion about sending out emails.
