WHAT IS EARLY COLLEGE ACADEMY?

Early College Academy (ECA) at Hoover High School offers an innovative pathway for students to concurrently earn a high school diploma and 46 college units in the time it takes to graduate high school. ECA integrates college classes into the high school bell schedule, allowing students the opportunity to **earn up to 2 years of college courses for FREE** - saving parents and students time *and* money.

The program is open to all GUSD students entering the 9th or 10th grade; those with a resident school other than Hoover must obtain an intra-district permit and transfer to Hoover to enroll in the ECA. Contact GUSD Career & College Division for requests.
