



## NONRESIDENT TUITION FEE WAIVER

The Nonresident Tuition Fee Waiver form must be filled out each semester. Please send the completed form and supporting documents to **Residency@glendale.edu**.

If approved this waiver will allow students to pay the in-state tuition rate per unit instead of the non-resident tuition fees. Eligibility for this waiver is in accordance with California Education Code (76140). This waiver is for students who are citizens and residents of a foreign country, or who are legally precluded from establishing residency in California, who do not meet AB-540 eligibility, and have demonstrated their financial need makes it challenging to pay out-of-state tuition. Such individual exemptions shall not be granted more than ten percent (10%) of the non-resident student population. **\*\*This waiver may not be combined with other waivers. Only a limited number of waivers can be approved, not all applications will be granted. See page 3 for visa/status types that qualify.**
